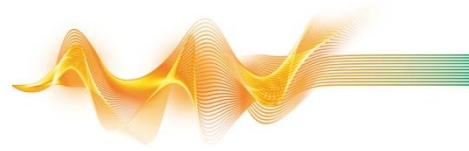

The proven TITANUS<sup>®</sup> air sampling smoke detectors will also be on display. **TITANUS TOP-SENS<sup>®</sup>**, for example, protects the famous Elbphilharmonic Concert Hall in Hamburg. The detectors have established themselves as standard in early fire detection and prove themselves both where, for example, the architecture makes high aesthetic demands but also in the most difficult areas of application.

Furthermore, interested parties will find information about firefighting with the FirExting<sup>®</sup> gas extinguishing system and the VisuLAN<sup>®</sup> hazard management system. The live presentation of the active fire prevention system OxyReduct<sup>®</sup> is particularly impressive. In the OxyReduct<sup>®</sup> cabin visitors can test interactively how controlled oxygen reduction prevents a fire.

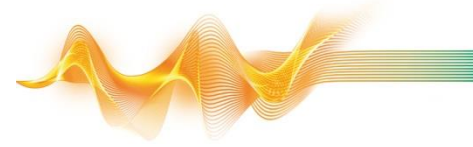
